**Baana son of Ahilud**—in Taanach and Megiddo, and in all of Beth Shan next to Zarethan below Jezreel, from Beth Shan to Abel Meholah across to Jokmeam

**Ben-Geber**—in Ramoth Gilead (the settlements of Jair son of Manasseh in Gilead were his, as well as the district of Argob in Bashan)

**Ahinadab son of Iddo**—in Mahanaim

**Ahimaaz**—in Naphtali

**Baana son of Hushai**—in Asher and in Aloth

**Jehoshaphat son of Paruah**—in Issachar

**Shimei son of Ela**—in Benjamin

**Geber son of Uri**—in Gilead

## **Daily Provisions for the Palace**

10 stall-fed cattle

20 pasture-cattle

100 sheep and goats

5 tons\* (180 bushels) of flour

10 tons\* (360 bushels) of meal

assorted wild fowl, deer and the like.

\* assumes a bushel of flour weighs 55#
